# Heavy Colds Policy

### HEAVY COLD POLICY

I (childminder) am happy to take children who have a cold. However, with heavy colds (constant coughing, runny noses and sneezing) please note that the child concerned must be well enough to still go on outings, attend playgroups etc.

If you still intend to send a child to my setting with a cold, should I (childminder) then feel that the child is unwell, you or your emergency contact must be able to immediately collect your child upon being contacted by myself (childminder).

When a child attends with a cold, please provide plenty of facial tissues and extra baby wipes.

If Calpol is to be given, a completed permission form needs to be handed to me (childminder) upon arrival. Please note that if the child is unwell, I (childminder) will not repeatedly administer calpol to keep the child well enough to remain at the setting for their full session, I (childminder) find that if they repeatedly require calpol, they will normally be happier and more comfortable resting at home with their parents.
