Road Safety Policy

I make sure when I am out that the child walks on the inside of the pavement, keeping a tight hold of my hand or buggy

I set a good example

I talk to the children about stopping at the kerb, looking and listening to traffic before crossing the road

I explain the difference between the road and the pavement and what traffic is: that the road is for traffic and the pavement is for people.

I explain that it is safe to walk on the pavement and very dangerous to walk on the road without a adult

I explain that sometimes traffic does cross the pavement so that they must always keep looking especially in town, railway crossings and at seaside resorts for example

I explain that roads are dangerous and that it is important to hold hands and to always listen before taking a step onto the road
